That *Michael Borew* ——— having served faithfully and honorably for the Term of — *Four* ——— Months, from the *Twenty fifth* — day of *July* 1835 — until the *Twenty fifth* — day of *November* 1836 — and having *Been honorably Discharged from the Army.* is entitled to *Three Hundred and Twenty* ——— Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *Michael Borew*, is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

In Testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my Hand, at *Houston* this *Twelfth* — day of *July*. 1839.

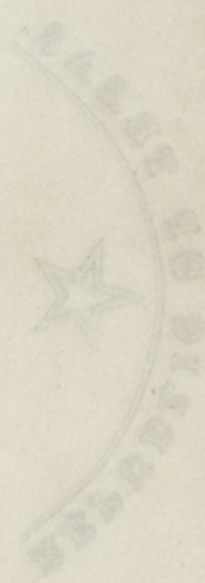

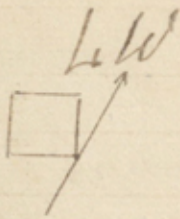
