

Jacob de Cordova of the County of  
Harris My Agent and Attorney  
in fact, to procure from the proper  
officer of the Government of the Republic  
of Texas a patent for my head right claim  
of six hundred and forty acres of land,  
secured to me by virtue of Conditional  
Land Certificate No 605 issued by the  
Board of Land Commissioners for Harris  
County Issued on July 5th 1838 Made  
unconditional by virtue of Land Certificate  
No 496 issued 3rd Feb<sup>r</sup> 1845 by the Board of Land  
Commissioners of Harris County, hereby  
empowering my said attorney to sign seal  
and deliver, any receipt, Bond or other  
obligation, necessary and proper in order  
to procure the said patent, and binding  
myself heirs and assigns to satisfy and  
conform, whatsoever my said attorney  
may lawfully do in the premises
