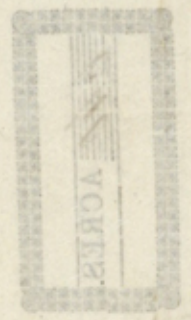

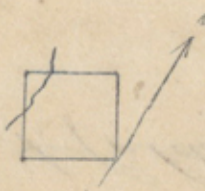

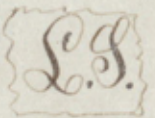

Office a Patent to which I am entitled by virtue of my
head right Certificate, No 125 issued by the Board of Land
Commissioners of Galveston County and I do hereby author-
ize my aforesaid attorney to seal sign and deliver any instru-
ment that may be required and I hereby ratify & confirm
all his legal acts in the Premises In Witness whereof I
have subscribed my name and affixed my Seal (scrawl
for Seal) in the City of Galveston this 1st day of August
in the Year of our Lord 1845.
