appeared before us, the BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS for the County
aforesaid, and proved according to law, that he arrived in this Republic in
^{seventeen years of age}
previous ^{1st} January eighteen hundred and forty two that he is a
single man, and having never received a Certificate for the quantity
of land for which he applies, is entitled to an unconditional grant of
three hundred & twenty ACRES OF LAND, in accordance with
an act of Congress approved. 4th January 1845

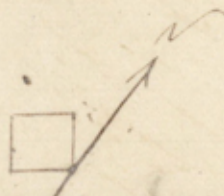
