proved according to Law, that he arrived in this Republic -
subsequent to the ~~first~~ Declaration of Independence
that he is a single man, that he came ^{in March in the year} as a volunteer, ¹⁸³⁶
and served a tour in the Army and received an hon-
ourable discharge - and is entitled to One third of a
League of Land - to be surveyed after the first day
of August 1838. - Given under our hands at Washing-
ton this 22 day of March 1838. -
