This is to certify that Samuel Johnson has appeared before us the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Galveston and proved according to law that he emigrated to this Republic in the Month of July A.D. 1839, that he resided permanently in and was an actual citizen of this Republic three years, and performed all the duties required of him as a citizen that he is a single man and that he has never hitherto obtained a Head right certificate for land and is therefore entitled to an unconditional grant of three hundred and twenty acres of land in accordance with an act of Congress approved the 16th January A.D. 1843
