This is to certify that Henry Hubbell has appeared before us the Board of Land Commissioners of the County of Galveston and proved according to Law that he emigrated to Texas on December 29th 1839. That he has resided three years permanently & continuously in the Republic that he has done and performed all the duties required of him as a Citizen - That he is a single man having never heretofore in this or any other County of the Republic received a conditional or unconditional certificate for the quantity of land for which he applies, is now entitled to an unconditional grant of three hundred & twenty acres of land under an act of Congress approved July 10. 1843. Given under our hands this the 10th of October A.D. 1845 -
