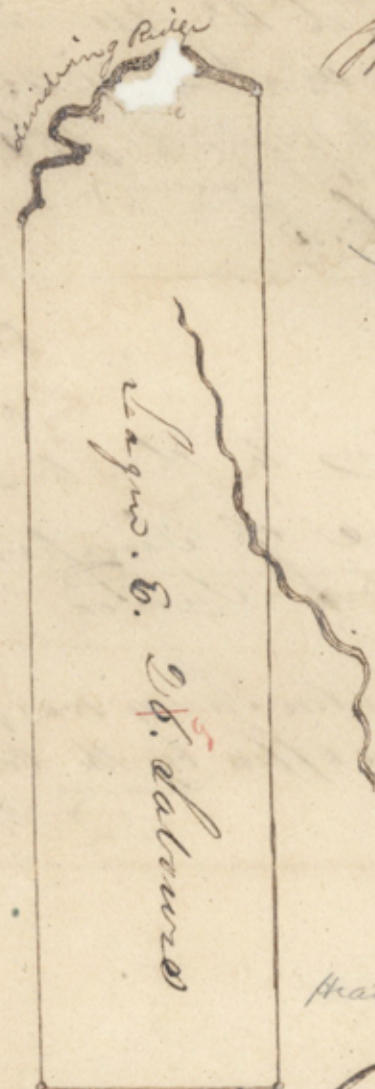

 Certificate No 113. Issued by the Board of
 Land Commissioners for the County of Jasper
 Survey (E.) Meandering the divide that
 divided the waters of the Colorado and Brazos
 Beginning at the N.W. corner of Quarter No 1.
 Meandering said divide entered in the name
 of W. H. Bell of the office of Winford Bailey a post
 from which a line at 12 1/2 inches diameter
 bore N 19° W 9 1/2 rods a black oak 7 1/2 inches bore
 S 39° W 25 rods from thence running N 71° E 91 91
 rods to the S.W. corner of Quarter No 6. It being
 for the S.E. corner of said section from which
 from which a post at 50 inches bore S 44° E.
 10 rods N. 17. inches bore N 19° W thence N 19° W
 25 rods and as a stake for N.E. corner of said
 section from which a post at 14 1/2 inches bore S 63° E
 17 rods N. 18. inches bore S 54° E 11 rods thence N 71° W

County of ^{us} Pasper } that I Rachel Saul do by these
presents fully and completely according to Law
appoint Joseph M Glasscock my true and lawful
attorney for me and in my name to get out an
order of survey for my headright in Land being
Justly and Lawfully intitled to one League and labour
of land agreeable to the Laws of this government be-
ing a widow of family being a citizen of Texas
for four years I hereby these presents, the commissio-
ner in the district where my said attorney may think
proper to lay my headright to make him a deed to
it in his own name if it can be don for he is Justly
intitled to is for the consideration of five hundred
dollars to me paid in hand the Receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged by me I do by these presents
sign all weight title and intrust to my said attorne-
y to my headright in Land my heirs executors admi-
strators or assigns I hereby declare all the acts of my
said attorney to be as binding on me as thou don by
own proper person hereby renouncing all Laws or
or parts of Law that ~~that~~ may or can affect the form
or validity or intention of this power of attorney
hereby submitting my self to the honorable Judiciary
of this state I hereby declare all the acts of my said ^{attorney} in
the premises to be as binding on me as thou don by my
self I hereby declare this power of attorney to be
Irrevocable For the consideration above mentioned
in good faith whereunto I have set my hand and
seal in the presents of the subscribing witnesses this
the fifth day of October in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven I hereby
authorize all notarys to acknowledge this power of attorney
