James Howe has appeared before us, the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Harris and proved according to law, that he arrived in this Republic previous to Jan'y 1<sup>st</sup> 1842 and that he has been a Resident Citizen up to the present time; that he is a single man, and therefore entitled to Three hundred and twenty acres of Land, to be Entered and Surveyed from any Vacant Land of the Republic. This cert being issued in lieu of Constitutional Certificate No. 585 of<sup>o</sup> by the Harrisburg Co. Board of Comrs Nov 21. 1839
