That he never has hitherto applied for his headright to any board of any County in this Republic

This is therefore to certify that he is entitled to three hundred & twenty Acres of Land, to be entered and surveyed from any vacant Land of the Republic.

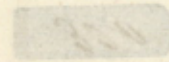
