This is to certify that John J. Hammen
has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners
for the County of Galveston and sworn according to Law
that he arrived in this Country on the 15th day of October
A.D. 1841, that he has been an actual citizen of this
Republic for the full term of three Years and done and
performed all the duties required of him as a citizen
that he is a single man and entitled to an uncon-
ditional grant of three hundred and twenty acres
of land in accordance with an act of Congress approved
the 10th day of January A.D. 1843

of twenty five dollars to me in hand paid to my full satis-
faction the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged have
bargained sold aliened transferred and set over, and
by these presents do bargain sell transfer and set over
unto J Temple Caswell all my right title interest claims
and demands in and to the Certain Land Certificate Map
4 Number 105, granted to me by the Ward of Land
Commissioners, for the County of Galveston, and dated
the 2nd day of June A.D. 1845, and three hundred and
twenty acres of Land surveyed or to be surveyed out of
the public domain of the Republic of Texas, by virtue of
said above mentioned certificate, together with all the
rights, privileges, immunities and appurtenances there-
unto belonging or in any way appertaining or incident
To have and to hold the said above described Land
Certificate and premises unto the said J Temple Caswell
his heirs and assigns forever; and I the said John J. Har-
rison do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators to warrant and firm defend all and
singular the above described Land claim and premises
unto the said J Temple Caswell his heirs and assigns against
every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
the same or any part thereof, and I the said John J. Har-
rison doth furthermore hereby authorize the Commissioners
of the General Land office or other person the proper officers
of the Government of Texas to issue to the said Caswell his
heirs or assigns, in his or their own proper names, a patent or
patents for the said three hundred and twenty acres of Land
surveyed or to be surveyed by virtue of these presents, truly satisfy-
ing all and whatsoever may be lawfully and in the premises
