This is to certify that Elijah Blakeman has appeared before us the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Galveston and sworn according to law that he emigrated to this Republic in the month of December A.D. 1839 that he has been an actual citizen of this Republic three years that he is a married man and has resided permanently in this Republic with his family since the month of May A.D. 1840 and having never received a certificate for more than three hundred and twenty acres of land is therefore entitled to an unconditional grant of three hundred and twenty acres of land as augmentation

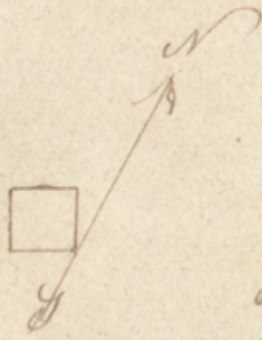
