1842 That he has been a resident Citizen to the present time, and applies as a

single man.

That he received a Conditional headright certificate from the Board of Land Commissioners of the County of Liberty for 320 acres N. 165 dated Jan 2 1840.

It is therefore to certify that he is entitled to three hundred and twenty Acres of Land, to be entered and surveyed from any vacant Land of the Republic.
