County of Washington This is to certify that Oliver Debrando has appeared before the Board of Land Commissioners for the County of Washington and proved according to Law that he arrived in Texas as a Volunteer before the first day of March and before the 1st day of August 1836 - a Single man and is entitled to One Third of a League of Land upon the Condition of his paying at the rate of five dollars for each labor of Temporal or Arable Land and all Town 50<sup>th</sup> Dollars for each labor of Pasture Land which may be contained in the Survey secured to him by this Certificate

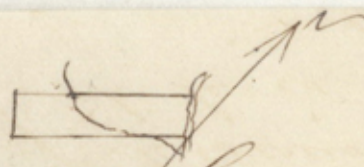

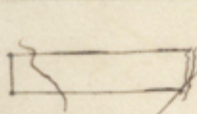
