The title for which land I acquired for my said right, from the Government of the Republic of Texas, as will be evidenced by Certificate Number 1539 issued by the Board of Land Court for Harris County on the Sixth day of April A.D. 1846, which said certificate accompanies this Deed and is made part hereof

**TO HAVE AND TO HOLD** all and singular the above described land, with the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining unto him the said John Beck his heirs and assigns forever, in fee simple.

And I the said Samuel S. McGuire do by this act bind myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the above described land & City Rights with the rights, privileges and appurtenances, unto him the said John Beck

his heirs and assigns, against the claim or claims of all, each and every person lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof, by right, title or claim by, through or under me, and I do hereby transfer all the rights and privileges granted me by my vendor and against the claims of all persons whosoever
