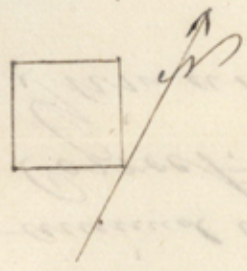

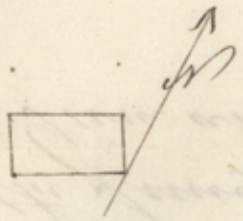

 and two (302) issued by the Board of Land
