We the undersigned a BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS for the County aforesaid, do hereby certify that *the Heirs of Pallas Gove* has appeared before us and proved according to law, that he emigrated to Texas previous *to the first day of August 1836.* was a soldier in the *Army of Santa Republic of Texas* and received an honorable discharge, and that he held a *Citizen of Santa Republic* having never received a Certificate of Head Right.

This is therefore to declare that the said *Pallas Gove* by his heirs is entitled to an unconditional headright of *one third of a League* of Land out of any of the unappropriated public domain of Texas.

Given under our hands this *fourth day* of *May* A. D. 184*7*.

Mr Tom. L. Green Co. Surveyor
of Bosque Co has I suppose sent
you field notes for a Homestead Ho-
mestead for one G. W. Pettie, who has
squatted on a portion of the Pallas Cove
& Corttender surveys, claiming the
land is vacant. I have owned the
land, and paid taxes on same for 13
years, and part of the land is fenced.
Different parties have tried in the
last ten years to locate vacant
land between the Pallas Cove and
Corttender surveys, and I have
tried myself under the same law
as I was anxious for the land if

was vacant as it lies in the middle
of my Chap ranche. But the Land
officer has heretofore always decided
then was no vacant land there, and
under those decisions, I have been noting
easy - Of course I don't know what
your decision will be in the matter, but
it certainly seems to me, that if you
were to declare the land vacant, that
it would be nothing but just and
right - that I should have the first
show to locate the land. The land
is only fit for grazing purposes not exceeding
5-acres land in the 133 acres fit
for cultivation, and the party settling
in it has not a single head of stock,
and can't possibly make a living on it,
and has never intended to live on it.
is camped under a wagon shed, and is
only doing it for Black mail, thinking
that I will pay him to get off -
I trust your just decision in the
matter - I am.
