When this acceptance is executed, it should be returned to me together with the sum of \$1345.60, which, according to my calculation, is the amount due on the excess acreage listed above. The check for the above sum should be made payable to the State Treasurer.

In addition to this sum, it will be necessary to forward a separate check for \$2.04 to defray the expense of recording the deeds of acquittance in the counties where the land is located. The check for this latter sum should be made payable to the Commissioner of the General Land Office.

Upon receipt of the acceptance properly executed and the sums above mentioned, deeds of acquittance will be issued and forwarded to the County Clerk for record with instructions to forward to you when the same is recorded.
