This is to Certify that Pedro Lopez
has appeared before us the Board of Land Commissioners
for the County of Washington and proved according to
Law that he was a Citizen of Texas at the date of the
Declaration of Independence, that he is a Native -
Mexican, and is a Single man, and entitled
to One third of a League of Land, Upon the Condi-
tion of paying at the rate of Five dollars for every
labor of Arable or Temporal Land and Two ^{40/100} -
dollars for every labor of Pasture Land which
may be contained in the Survey Secured to him
by this Certificate - Given under our hands this
22 day of March 1835.
