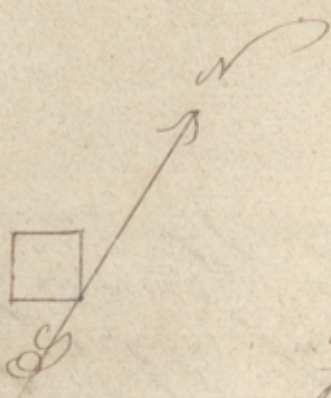

him the said John J Giddings his heirs
and assigns forever, and I hereby covenant
and agree to warrant and forever defend
the said Certificate to be a genuine and legal
Claim against the Government of Texas and
I authorize and empower him the said
Giddings, to demand and receive a patent
therefor in his own name, to locate survey
and do all acts necessary in order to obtain
the same, and I the said Abram G Compton
do hereby bind myself my heirs &
executors or administrators, in the sum of One
thousand Dollars to make all such
further titles, and deeds of conveyance as
may be necessary in order to fully vest

a good, and sufficient title to said
land in the said Giddings his heirs or
assigns forever
