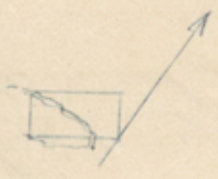



Thomas and his heirs,) my heridright claim to 320 acres of land; the Constitutional Certificate for which was issued by the board of Land Commissioners of this County (Jasper) and the unconstititional Certificate by the board of Land Commissioners of this County on the 4th day of July 1862. Do hereby conveying and releasing to the said Jesse G. Thomas and his heirs all the right, title and interest which may have accrued or which may hereafter accrue to me in virtue of said Certificates
