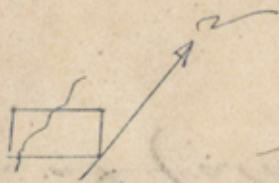

presence that I, ^{H. Smith} William Smith of the County aforesaid
For and in consideration of the sum of eighteen
dollars to me in hand paid by Frederick Schubling
of said County, the receipt whereof is here by
acknowledged. Have bargained sold and conveyed, and
by these presents do bargain sell & convey to the said
Schubling his heirs and assigns all my right title
and interest claim and demand what so ever to me
be longing or in any wise appertaining in and to
a certain Certificate of Land, Granted to me by the
County Court acting as a Board of Land Commission-
ers for said County on the ~~6th~~ ^{6th} day of
January one thousand eight hundred and forty five
being no 31 For three hundred and twenty acres
and the said Schubling his heirs and assigns are fully
authorized to have the same located upon any vacant
land in this Republic according to Law and to receive
from the proper Officers of government the title
Patent or Patents in his or their names if the laws will
allow it, and I will, should, it be required to furnish the
said Schubling further assurances as to vouchers or docu-
mentary evidence to fully secure the peaceful and quiet
possession of the same To have and to hold injoy or
to dispose of the same at will and pleasure. And by these
presents the said Schubling his heirs and assigns in the possession of
said three hundred and twenty acres of land will for
ever warrant and defend whereunto I have set my
hand and seal this the 28th day of April one
thousand eight hundred and forty five
