Patton* having served faithfully and honorably for the term of *Twenty* Months from the *Thirtieth* day of *March* 1836 until the *twenty* day of *April* 1837 and having been honorably discharged is entitled to *two hundred eighty* Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said *William H. Patton* is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

in the Republic of Texas, in consideration of  
Three Thousand Dollars, to me paid by Edwin  
J. Plish, and William St. Foster, both of the  
City of Galveston, Republic aforesaid, the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given, granted,  
bargained, and sold, and by these presents I do  
give, grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Plish  
and Foster, and their heirs, assigns, one  
certain Land Warrant, numbered (3520)  
and for Twelve hundred and Eighty Acres  
of Land, and the same granted to me for  
my services in the Army of Texas. And  
I, the said Patton, do hereby for myself and  
my heirs, executors, and administrators, covenant  
with the said Plish & Foster, their heirs and assigns,  
that I have a good right to dispose of the  
said Warrant, and that I warrant and defend  
the same against the claims of all persons  
whatsoever. And I further warrant the  
said Warrant & guarantee to them the said  
Plish & Foster, their heirs & assigns, that the  
same is genuine. Said warrant was issued  
by the Secretary of the War Department on this



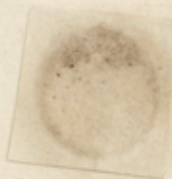
