THAT Samuel Potter having served faithfully and honorably for the term of nine months from the fourteenth day of February 1837 until the fifteenth day of November 1837 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to four hundred and eight Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Samuel Potter is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

for and in consideration of the sum of *four hundred and eighty* dollars, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and so far as the ability exists in me, delivered possession of, to *Proctor P Hosley of the city of Houston,* four hundred and eighty acres of land to which I am entitled as a *Soldiers bounty* in the **REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.** And I authorise the said *Proctor P Hosley* his — heirs or assigns, to locate the said *four hundred and eighty* acres of land, to which I am entitled as a *Soldier* in any part of the Republic that he may deem proper; and to call upon the proper officer, who is hereby authorised to issue to the said *Proctor P Hosley* the necessary title to the same.

And I authorise the said *Proctor P Hosley* his — heirs or assigns, to enter upon, when located, said land, and to use and enjoy, and dispose of the same as his own property, acquired by a just and legal title.

AND WHEREAS, There is ^{his & that} a Notary present, I sign the same in presence of the undersigned witnesses, in order, and for the purpose of making it a Notarial act, with executive force, having the same qualities as a final judgment; and I vest in the judge of the jurisdiction in which said land may be located full and ample authority to act on this instrument, for the purpose of carrying it into effect.
