This is to Certify that Joseph Frank
-lin Beavill has appeared before us the
-board of Land Commissioners for the County
of Austin and sworn according to Law that
he Emigrated to this Republic previous to the
first of August 1836 that he is a single
man and entitled to one third of a League
of Land according to the provisions of the
29th section of the Land Law under the
Condition of paying at the rate of \$2⁴⁰
for each Labor of Pasture Land and \$5- for
Each Labor of arable Land which may
be contained in the survey secured to
him by this Certificate
