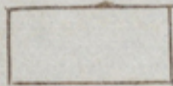

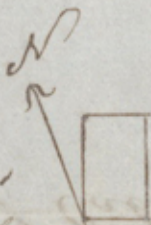

for and in consideration of the sum of *Five Hundred* dollars, to me  
in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, and so far as the ability  
exists in me, delivered possession of, to *Samuel S. Allen* one third of  
a league of land the same being my headright  
to which I am entitled as a *Volunteer Soldier* in the **REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.** And I  
authorise the said *Samuel S. Allen* his heirs or assigns, to locate the said  
*third of a league* of land, to which I am entitled as a \_\_\_\_\_ in any  
part of the Republic that he may deem proper; and to call upon the proper officer, who is hereby authorised  
to issue to the said *Samuel S. Allen* the necessary title to the same.

And I authorise the said *Samuel S. Allen* his heirs or assigns, to  
enter upon, when located, said land, and to use and enjoy, and dispose of the same as his own property,  
acquired by a just and legal title.

AND WHEREAS, There is <sup>a</sup> ~~is~~ Notary present, I sign the same in <sup>his</sup> ~~the~~ presence of the undersigned wit-  
nesses, in order, and for the purpose of making it a Notarial act, with executive force, having the same  
qualities as a final judgment; and I vest in the judge of the jurisdiction in which said land may be located  
full and ample authority to act on this instrument, for the purpose of carrying it into effect.
