THAT Charles Williams having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Three months from the Twenty first day of July 1836 until the First day of October 1836 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to Three hundred and twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said C. Williams or assigns is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.
