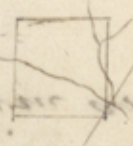

further authorize and empower him to apply
for and receive a patent from the Commission
of the Genl Land Office for said Land in his the
said J S Roberts own name for the aforesaid six
Hundred and forty acres as by Law he is entitled

I declare that I am the owner of said Land by
virtue of my Certificate of Head Right No 684
unconditional for 640 acres of Land issued by the Board
of Land Commissioners for Harris County on the
(27th) Twenty seventh day of July 1846

assigns forever and the title to which I warrant
and forever defend against any and all persons
claiming the same to the said J S Roberts
