And the said John Furnash, by J. W. Porter a private is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

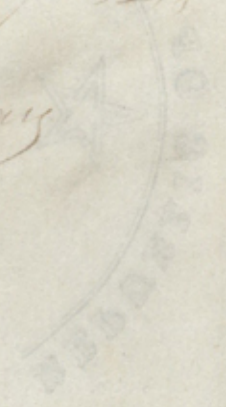

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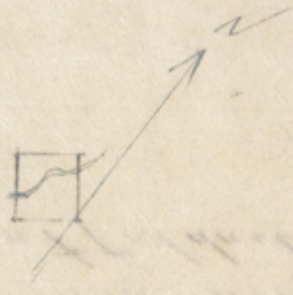
