That John Shell having served faithfully and honorably for the Term of Three Months, from the first day of May 1835 until the first day of August 1835 and having been honorably discharged is entitled to Three Hundred and Twenty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said John Shell by his agent W. P. Buckner is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

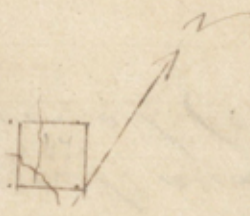
