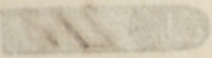

Know all men by these presents that I John C Crane of the County of Galveston, Tex and in consideration of the sum of Fifty Five Dollars to me in hand paid to my full satisfaction by John S Jones of the County of Galveston State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained sold assigned transferred and set over, and by these presents do grant bargain sell assign transfer and set over unto the said John S Jones of the County and State aforesaid all my right title interest claim and demand in and to my Headright Certificate No 213, 2nd Class for three hundred and twenty acres of land granted to me by the board of Land Commissioners for the County of Galveston and dated the 4th day of May, A D 1846 together with all the lands, rights, perquisites, improvements, and appurtenances, to the same belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. I have and to hold all and singular the said above mentioned and described certificate, together with any and all lands located and surveyed upon and by virtue thereof unto him the said John S Jones his heirs and assigns forever and I the said John C Crane do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and prove defend all and singular the above mentioned premises unto him the said John S Jones his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, and I do furthermore, by these presents authorize and empower the Commissioners of the General Land Office or other person or persons the proper Officers of the State of Texas to issue unto the said John S Jones his heirs or assigns, a patent or title in his or their own proper name or names, for any and all lands located and

and arranged under and by virtue of said above descri-
bed Certificate, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs
executors and administrators, to make sign seal and
deliver all and any such further deed or deed transfer
or assurances, as shall be reasonably advised or advised
for the more fully assuring and confirming the same
unto the said John C. Crane his heirs or assigns
