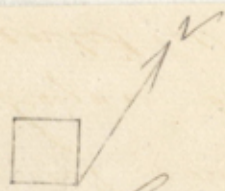

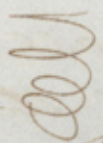

Chapman and for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seven Dollars to me in hand paid by Oscar Farish of the City of Galveston I have this day granted, bargained, sold, transferred, aliened, assigned & set over by these presents do grant bargain sell, transfer alien, assign & set over to the said Farish his heirs & assigns all my right, title & interest of in & to my unconditional grant for three hundred & twenty acres of land granted to me by the Board of Land Comm^r Galveston County No. 57 & dated Apr. 5. 1844⁽¹⁸⁴⁶⁾ And I also grant, convey & assign to said Farish all the land which may be surveyed & patented by virtue of said grant. To have and to hold the said grant above described with all the land surveyed & located or to be located surveyed & patented under the virtue of the same to him said Farish his heirs & assigns forever And I hereby authorize & require the Com^r of the General Land Office or other proper officer to issue a patent for the land to be surveyed or which may be surveyed as aforesaid to said Farish as my assignee.
