County of Bexar, a survey of 40
acres made for Ward Keeler it being the
title of a part of the quantity of land to
which he is entitled by virtue of Land Warrant
No. 237 issued by the Commissioner of the
General Land Office August 14. 1857
situated ^{in Bexar County} on the north side of the main
Bexar River below the mouth of Duffans
Creek, about 11 miles N 27° W. from Meridian.

Beginning at 290 rods from the
SE corner of a survey made in the name of
Lydia Hilliard for the SE corner of this
survey in the head of a branch from which
a Spruce oak marked I bears N 56° 34' W
11 rods thence S 60° 20' W 200 rods crossed a branch 300
rods measured it 475 rods to the SE corner
from which a Post oak marked J bears N 60°
11' W 11 rods and another marked K bears S 60°
6' W 6 rods thence S 60° W 190 rods crossed a

oak marked G bears S 70 E 99 varas and
another marked H bears S 52 E 109 varas
Thence S 61 W 60 varas crossed a branch
672 varas to the S.W. corner from which
a Post oak marked I bears S 36 E 6 varas
and another marked J bears S 71 W 11 varas
Thence S 30 E 672 varas to the beginning.
