This is to certify that George Hartney  
has appeared before us the Board of Land  
Commissioners for the County of Galveston and  
proved according to Law that he emigrated  
to this Republic in the month of November  
A.D. 1838, that he resided in and was an  
actual citizen of the Republic of Texas three  
years and performed all the duties required of  
him as a citizen that he is a single man  
and that he has never hitherto obtained a grant  
for land he is therefore entitled to an uncon-  
ditional grant of three hundred and twenty  
acres of land in accordance with the provisions  
of a Law approved the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January  
A.D. 1843

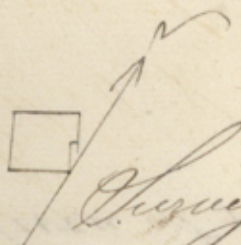
