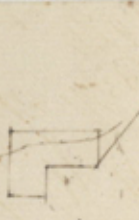

issued to me by the Board of Land Commissioners

of May A.D. 1846 un- Conditional
Fourth Class for three hundred and twenty
Acres of land which Certificate is herewith
delivered to the said Jacob de Cordova
with all and singular all of the rights
and privileges to which I am entitled by
Law issuing out of the same. I have and
to hold the same to the said Jacob de Cordova
his heirs and assigns forever. And I the
said Stephen J. Slater do hereby bind myself my heirs &
executors and administrators to warrant & forever
defend the right title & quietness of the
said Certificate to the said Jacob de Cordova
his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs and
against every other person or persons claiming the
same in any manner whatever -

grant, bargain sell and release unto the said W^m
R. Baker his heirs and assigns forever, three hundred
and twenty one certificates, issued in Montgomery
County to Stephen F. Statu - W^m 418 - dated 4th May 1846
which said certificates I have located near the
Trago River above Childers Creek, in Milam County
adjoining a survey which fronts on said River,
together with all the rights and privileges belonging
to said certificates, To have and to hold said
certificates to him the said William R. Baker his
heirs and assigns in fee simple forever, hereby
agreeing to warrant said claim & the title ~~to~~ to
the land on which this is located, against all claims
arising through me
