That Peter Wood having served faithfully and honorably for the Term of Six Months, from the Twenty-fifth day of June 1836 until the Seventeenth day of December 1836 and having been honourably discharged is entitled to Six hundred and Forty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said Peter Wood, is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.
