

these presents authorize the sd S. L. Allen the sd
to apply for a patent to said certificate in my name
or his own as the Law may require, and the said
as my agent has full power to
appoint one or more subagents, if necessary
to assist in procuring a perfect patent
in the name of the sd Sam. L. Allen as my
agent or in the name of his subagents or in the
name of any person he or they may see fit to
have by ratifying and confirming every act

of the said _____ as my agent and his
subagents may do in ~~pro~~ ~~form~~ giving full
power to my agent and his subagents to use
or dispose of the aforesaid own property acquired
by just and legal title.

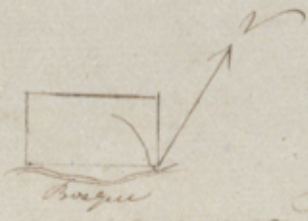
