To all to whom these Presents shall come, know ye

I Sam Houston GOVERNOR of the STATE aforesaid, by virtue of the power vested in me by LAW and in accordance with the LAWS of SAID STATE in such case made and provided, do by these presents GRANT to Elijah Burch as exec of William S Kidd his heirs or assigns FOREVER, Eighty acres of LAND, situated and described as follows: In Bosque county on Rocky creek tributary of the Brazos River about 10 1/2 miles S 75 E from Meridian By virtue of Land Scrip No. 27 issued by the Commissioner of the General Land Office on the 8th January 1858 in accordance with an Act passed 26th August 1856 and transferred by William S Kidd to Elijah Burch on the 26th April 1858.

Beginning N 60 E 670 vs and N 50 W 540 vs from the NW corner of a Survey in the name of William Parvin for the SW corner of this Survey from which a Live oak marked @ N 40 W 25 vs another marked P N 4 W 33 vs Thence N 60 E 370 vs crossed Rocky creek 672 vs to the SE corner from which a Spanish Oak marked R N 60 E 2 vs Thence N 30 W 672 vs to the NE corner in prairie Thence S 60 W 672 vs to the NW corner from which an Elm marked S N 53 E 35 vs another marked T N 72 1/2 E 40 vs Thence S 30 E 240 vs crossed Rocky creek 672 vs to the place of beginning

Hereby relinquishing to him the said Elijah Burch and his heirs or assigns FOREVER all the right and title in and to said LAND, heretofore held and possessed by the said STATE, and I do hereby issue this Letter Patent for the same.
