authorized Surveyor, upon any of the vacant and unappropriated domain of the State of Texas within

the limits of said "Reserve," Eighty

Acres of Land to be surveyed in as square, should surveys made before the passage of the act in-

corporating the Mississippi and Pacific Railroad, (December 21st., 1855,) admit of it.

80 acres of land made
for Robert A. Hester, it being the
quantity of land to which he is enti-
tled by virtue of Land Sale
No. 286 issued by the Commissioner
of the General Land Office Aug-
ust 1st. A.D. 1857, situated ^{in Bosque County} on
Childers' Creek about 9 ¹/₂ miles
S 67° E - from Meridian.

Beginning at the N W corner
of a survey made in the name
of George Bond for the S W cor-
ner of this survey, a stake,
Thence N 60° E 150 varas across
Childers' creek 672 varas to the
S E corner in Prairie Thence
N 30° W 672 varas to the N E corner
a stake in Prairie. Thence S 60° W
672 varas to the N W corner in
prairie, Thence S 30° E 672 varas
to the beginning. Surveyed February

have this day bargained, sold, released,
alienated and conveyed, and do by these
presents bargain, sell, release, alienate,
and convey unto Simron Wise, of the
same State and County, all my right,
title, claim and interest in or to, a certain
Land Scrip issued by the Commissioner
of the General Land Office August the
1st 1857 for 50 acres of Land No. 286
to have and to hold all and singular,
the rights, profits and benefits therefrom
accruing, and I do further covenant to
warrant and forever defend the title of
said Scrip from the claim or claims of
all persons whomsoever claiming or to
claim the same either in law or equity
In testimony of which I hereunto set
my hand and seal, using a scroll
for seal this the 2nd day of February A.D.
