1350 ACRES.

KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Timothy W. Hawkins having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Fifteen months from the Fifth day of February 1834 until the twenty eighth day of May 1837 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to two hundred eighty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said T. W. Hawkins is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent Authority, with Witnesses to the same.

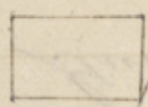
