KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME,

That John Cornin having served faithfully and honorably in the Army of the Republic of Texas, for the term of three Months, from the twenty second day of October 1835 until the twenty second day of January 1836 and having received an honorable discharge, his assignee S. B. Bailey is entitled to three hundred and twenty Acres

County Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said S. B. Bailey assignee of John Cornin is entitled to hold said Land; or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

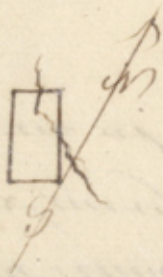
