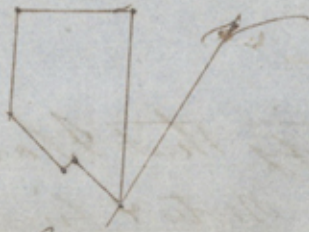

and eight Dollars ³⁴/₁₀₀ to me in hand paid by
Lee R. Davis of the same state
and County the receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged have granted bargained
and sold and by these presents
convey and confirm unto Lee R.
Davis his heirs or assigns forever
all my right title and interest in
a certain portion of my headright
certificate being a tract containing eleven
hundred and fifty six (1156) acres being
part of certificate Number 33 issued in the
County of Fort Bend on the day of
in the year 1838 to me as my headright
the whole being for one third of a league or
fourteen hundred and twenty six acres out
of which I have sold and transferred unto one
S. Carey an three hundred and twenty acres
and now I convey and confirm unto
said Lee R. Davis all the remainder
of said certificate being eleven hundred and
fifty six acres to use as his property to
locate the same and receive from the gene
land office a patent for the land in
in his own proper name or that of his
assigns and I the said John S. Long
unto the said Lee R. Davis his heirs and
assigns will warrant and defend the said claims
from myself and heirs and assigns as a legal genuine
claims in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
