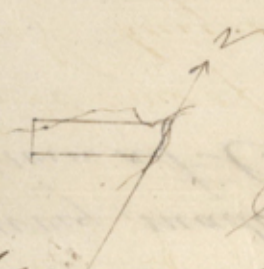

services, at Austin by W. G. Cooke for three hundred and twenty
acres, Numbered 10034. and dated twenty first day of November

tioned and described property unto the said Jacob De Cordova his heirs

assigns, against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
