KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT John Christie having served faithfully and honorably for the term of twenty months from the sum day of March 1830 until the thirtieth day of October 1834 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Mexico is entitled to seven hundred & fifty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said John Christie is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand,

I appear in a Public Office this day come & personally appeared Jacob D. Watkins of this County to me known, who declared under oath duly administered by me, that in the fall of 1837 John Christie, signed his name on the Back of Bounty Land Warrant, N^o 132 issued to him as his Bounty Land for being in the service of Texas from the 2^d day of March 1836 to the 7th day of October 1837 issued on the 7th day of November 1837. That the said Christie made a scribble for a seal, and declared that by his said act, he authorized John Beldin of Harris County to make a title for the same over his the said Christie's signature, to such person as the said Beldin, should sell the same, and that he the said Christie received the purchase money from said John Beldin. And the said Watkins further made oath that he signed the same as a witness together with S. Truman, and that he recognizes all the signatures both principal, and witnesses therein, to be genuine and original.

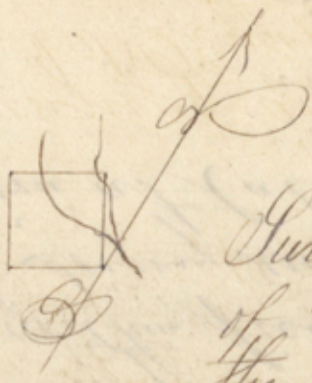
