REPUBLIC OF TEXAS.

ACRES.

KNOW ALL MEN TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

THAT Ym. Pollock having served faithfully and honorably for the term of Six months from the First day of March 1836 until the First day of October 1836 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to Six hundred forty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said Ym. Pollock is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

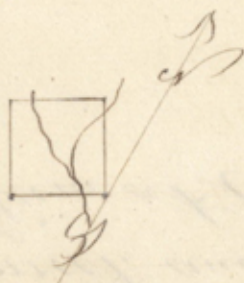
