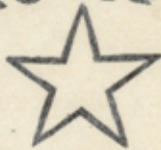

Edwards having served faithfully and honorably for the term of fourteen months from the eleventh day of September 1836 until the fifth day of November 1837 and being honorably discharged from the Army of Texas is entitled to Six hundred forty Acres Bounty Land, for which this is his Certificate.

And the said J. C. Edwards is entitled to hold said Land, or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same, and exercise all rights of ownership over it.

This Certificate will be transferable by Endorsement, with a Deed, before any competent authority, with witnesses to the same.

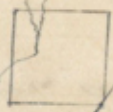

bargain, sell, alien, release, convey & confirm unto the
said A. W. Sillavren his heirs or assigns, all the
right, title, interest or Claim which I have in &
to a Certificate or Land warrant for six hundred and
forty acres of land No 258 & dated the 11th Novem-
ber 1837 — signed by Barnard E. Bee Sec. of War,
originally granted to Telford C. Edwards for Military
services, & by him, the said Edwards transferred to the
aforesaid A. W. Moore on the 20th day of November 1838
as will appear by reference to a title or conveyance
of that date now in my possession, witness by
