Thomas J. Green vs The Republic of Texas  
793  
In this case the plaintiff appeared by his counsel, and the District Attorney as well as J. S. Sullivan Esq. Assistant appointed by the Court, on the behalf of the Republic. Whereupon came the following jury, viz: - John Walnut, Jas. J. Perry, Joseph Hughes, John B. Harris, William P. Curtis, John James, R. J. W. Reel, George Armstrong, Jos. Collins, M. C. C. Lynch, C. Stringfellow and Wm Polite, who being sworn and having heard the evidence and argument of counsel, returned the following verdict, viz: - "We the jury find the plea of J. Green entitled to the amount of land claimed in his petition, viz: Two thirds of a league and one labor - John B. Harris - Freeman" It is therefore considered by the Court that the plaintiff has a certificate for two thirds of a League and a Labor of land as found by the jury aforesaid, and the Clerk is hereby required and advised to issue a certificate for the same to the Commissioners of the General Land Office on payment of the costs in this suit by the plaintiff -
