

Yates of Galveston Wiltmouth that whereas the
said party of the first part hath delivered
to said party of the second part a headright
certificate of said Rundel for 640 Acres of
land and the headright certificate of Benjamin F.
Rundel his son, late deceased, a minor, for 320
Acres of land, which said Yates is to locate, survey
and obtain patents for, at his own proper costs
and expenses, now therefore of said Yates shall
sell and truly do and perform as aforesaid, the
said John Rundel doth hereby bind himself
and his legal representatives, thereupon to make
to said Yates or his legal representatives, a good
and sufficient title to one third part of
said lands, to be divided off from the remain-
der in fair proportion of quality and location,
on the delivery of said patents.
