We, the undersigned BOARD OF LAND COMMISSIONERS for the County of Harris, do hereby Certify that William Williams dec^d by his adm^r appeared before us, and proved according to Law that he emigrated to Texas previous to the 10th of 1857 & did thereon that he rec^d a conditional cert^f from the Board of Land Commissioners of Harrisburg County for 540 acres W. S. 91 dated July 5th 1858.

This is therefore to declare that the said William Williams dec^d by his adm^r is entitled to an Unconditional Headright of six hundred forty Acres, by virtue of his emigration, and the above described Certificate heretofore issued.

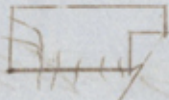
