Five Months, from the fourth day of June

1836 until the \_\_\_\_\_ day of

November 1836 and having enrolled for two

years and died in the service, his heirs are

entitled to Nineteen hundred & twenty acres

Bounty Land, for which this is his CERTIFICATE.

And the said heirs of Charles S. Brown are

entitled to hold said Land; or to sell, alienate, convey and donate the same; and to exercise all rights of ownership over it.

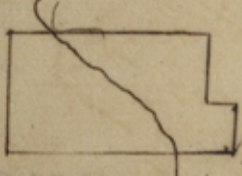
